

Douglas Keith Mills  
1927–2016

Dr. Keith Mills passed away 8 May 2016 in his 89th year. He is survived by his wife Patsy and brother Donald. Keith had an extensive educational background, which included the Royal Canadian Naval College, Carleton, McGill, and Western University. He was a practising psychiatrist in Montreal and Ottawa and held management positions at hospitals in Ottawa and Saskatoon. Dr. Mills became the first president of the Ottawa Psychoanalytic Society, which was founded in 1972 and was established as the fourth branch society in Canada at the time. Towards the end of his satisfying career, he was invited by the Medical School of the University of Saskatchewan, which was without a psychoanalytic division at the time, to enrich the school's teaching program as a full professor. Following his retirement, Keith and his wife moved back to Ottawa, enjoying life after retirement.
